Art Life in Colour

In our new unit we will be exploring colour and texture! We will refine our colour mixing skills and explore how to add texture to artworks, inspired by artists such as Romare Bearden. We will then apply these techniques to collage.

Send and Return

We will be focussing on the skills needed for a game of tennis and will learn how to serve accurately, change direction on court, get into the ready position and return the ball. We will apply our new skills into some team games.

<u>Place Value:</u> We will start the term with Place Value – focussing on reading numbers to 100. We will compare, sort, order and partition 2-digit numbers into different ways such as by tens and ones.

<u>Addition and Subtraction:</u> We will begin this unit by exploring addition and subtraction number facts.

<u>Reading:</u> Our reading text will be 'Traction Man.' We will also explore poetry and non-fiction texts.

<u>Writing:</u> This half term, we will focus on consolidating basic sentence structure including grammar and punctuation.

We will create descriptive pieces of writing based upon various texts including 'The Whales' Song' story.
