

In this unit pupils learn:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• what they like/dislike and are good at</li> <li>• what makes them special and how everyone has different strengths</li> <li>• how their personal features or qualities are unique to them</li> <li>• how they are similar or different to others, and what they have in common</li> <li>• to use the correct names for the main parts of the body, including external genitalia; and that parts of bodies covered with underwear are private</li> </ul>
