## Minutes

- Charities which are important to us: The Ukraine War (Unicef), Cancer Research, 'Daft as a Brush'
- Non Uniform Day Everyone pays £2 to come to school in their own clothes. It could be crazy clothes or clothes in a specific colour. I asked what if some families could not afford the £2 to pay for this. The children said that they could pay whatever they could afford.
- Sell some art from the children Lots of the children have done some wonderful art. This could be laminated or sold on canvases. We would have to make sure that we made more than what the canvases cost.
- Give things from home that we don't need any more to sell Toys, games, books. We could charge the children £2 each to take part in the sale.
- **'Sponsored Song'** We could learn a song and sing it as many times as we could for one hour. Families could sponsor us to do this. It would have to be a song which everyone liked and was an easy song for our youngest children to learn.
- **Sponsored 'Daily Mile'** We do the Daily Mile anyway so could we do this for 20 minutes instead of 10 and see if families would sponsor us.
- Toy or Book Swap Pay £2 to take part.
- 'Bike it Breakfast' Everyone could come to school on their bikes or scooters for one day. Mr
  Adams said that we might need to split this into year groups so that we have plenty of space to
  store the bikes and scooters.
