Art & Design
Take One Picture
Inspired by a painting from the National Gallery, we will explore the themes behind the artwork before creating our own response. We will then share this with the rest of school during the 'Take One Picture' whole school exhibition.

P.E: Attack, Defend, Shoot!
This half term we will be learning the different skills needed for Football and Basketball before applying these to team games. In football we will practise passing, dribbling and stopping the ball. In basketball, we will learn about bounce passing, dribbling and catching.

Maths
Addition and Subtraction – Continuing from last half term, we will build on our knowledge of addition and subtraction facts and learn how to add and subtract 2-digit numbers using different methods.
Geometry – We will identify and recognise 2D and 3D shapes. We will then investigate the shape's number of sides, vertices, faces and lines of symmetry.

English
Reading
We will be exploring a range of poetry before starting our class text for this half-term: Meerkat Mail by Emily Gravett.
Writing
We will look at a range of poetry around the theme of 'Fireworks' before creating our own poems. We will then write a recount of the events during the Great Fire of Gateshead and Newcastle!

History
Great Fire of London
We will investigate the events of the Great Fire of London and learn about cause and effect. We will visit the Discovery Museum and take part in a workshop about the Great Fire of Gateshead before comparing the two events.

Science
Living things and their habitats
Continuing with our topic from last half term, we will look at how habitats provide for the basic needs of living things. We will carry out different experiments to investigate why animals are suited to particular habitats.
