We will also plan, design and create our own tiles with a botanical theme.

Tennis

Maths

Length and perimeter:

This half term, we will learn about efficient ways to calculate the perimeter of a range of different shapes.

Fractions:

In this unit we will learn about proper and improper fractions and equivalence and will add and subtract fractions with the same denominator.

Literacy

We will begin this half term with poetry and will create our own poems based on 'The Lost Words' poetry anthology.

Discussion text: Improving Gosforth


Our focus for this writing unit will be nonfiction writing. We will research our local area, considering what could improve it, before writing a discussion piece based on our research and findings.

Geography

Biomes

This half-term we will be learning about the world's main climate zones and consider where our own locality fits in. We will learn about the tropics, longitude and latitude, climate and biomes before looking more closely at the human and physical geography of the poles.

Science

Sound

This half term we will be investigating how sounds are made and look at the features of different objects that enable them to produce specific sounds. We will carry out fair tests relating to volume and create our own comparative test to investigate the best materials for ear defenders.

Computing

3D Design and Coding

We will complete our 3D design projects before moving on to a new coding block. In this coding block, we will design sequences of code to create artwork and will refine our sequences to develop more efficient coding loops.

Linked to our Geography topic, we will look at how people have a shared responsibility for the world around them and how our everyday choices, such as spending, can affect this world.
